



Michelin Cup Supplementary Regulations

1. ARRANGEMENT

- 1.1. Michelin Cup 2013 is organized within the Latvian Rally Championship 2013.
- 1.2. Events take place according to the championship calendar of Latvian Autosport Federation (LAF).
- 1.3. Organizer is:
 - 1.3.1. Latvian Automobile Federation (address, Brivibas str. 224, K5, Riga, Latvia).
 - 1.3.2. **Triple M Llc** (Silikaltsiidi 3F, Tallinn 12116, Estonia; ph: +372 681 4099, fax: +372 681 4091, e-mail: info@mm-motorsport.ee).
- 1.4. Regulations can be changed by LAF in agreement with Triple M Llc. Amendments will take power after publishing on LAF's webpage www.autorally.lv or www.laf.lv;
- 1.5. Violation of the regulations will be resolved by MICHELIN Cup's commission, members of the commission are a representative of Triple M Llc, representative of the LAF rally commission and Chief Technical Scrutineer of the event in question.

2. MICHELINS CUP'S CLASSIFICATION

- 2.1. **MICHELIN-4WD** (WRC; A8; R4; N4; L13; L12; S2000; RRC; R5)
- 2.2. **MICHELIN -2WD** (N1;N2;N3, A5;A6;A7; R1;R2;R3)
- 2.3. **MICHELIN -National** (L8; L9; L10; L11)

3. REGISTRATION, TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

- 3.1. To participate in Michelin Cup, the driver must file an application on LAF's webpage www.autorally.lv or www.laf.lv or at the handing out of the reconnaissance materials in Rally HQ. Filed application will be in power through-out the whole season starting from the event when application was filed.
- 3.2. Participant of the Michelin Cup must use Michelin tyres or BF Goodrich in winter rallies and Michelin on each event on summer rallies and until the end of the event.
 - 3.2.1. Participants must use Michelin tyres with special marking "MMM". Special markings will be published in the Appendix of the Regulations.
- 3.3. Results of the Michelin Cup will be in accordance to the official results of the event along with all the penalties appointed by the Stewards and LAF. If the result is excluded, it is excluded in Michelin Cup classification as well.
- 3.4. Competitors using the Michelin tyres at ERC Latvian event will score the Michelin Cup points.

4. ATTRIBUTION OF POINTS

- 4.1. Attribution of points as shown in table 4.2., each Class has its separate score. Winner of the Class is competitor with the highest score of points from all events. In case of even score the winner is competitor who has more 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc positions through-out the season. If the score of positions is even, highest positions from the events, where both competitors have participated is taken into account. If these positions are even as well, the position from the last event, event before the last and etc will be taken into account.
- 4.2. Score of points by group:

5. OBLIGATION OF ADVERTISEMENT

Participants of MICHELIN Cup are obliged to follow the rules of advertisement:

- 5.1. Reserve the space for MICHELIN Cup's adverts as shown in Appendix 2 of the Regulations.
- 5.2. Use MICHELIN trademarks tyres on the Start/Finish podium (not demanded during winter rallies).

5.3. Wear MICHELIN promotional caps on the Start/Finish podium.

6. CONTROLL OVER FOLLOWING THE TERMS OF PARTICIPATION AND OBLIGATION OF ADVERTISEMENT. PENALTIES.

- 6.1. Judges of Facts will control the tyre use and fulfilment of the obligation of advertisement during the events.
- 6.2. Judges of Facts will report to the MICHELIN Cup's commission and commission may appoint penalties accordingly.
- 6.3. If participant is not fulfilling the terms described in point 3.2., MICHELIN Cup's commission will appoint the penalty up to the exclusion from the MICHELIN Cup.
- 6.4. Penalty for not following the obligation of advertisement is warning, annulment of the result of the event or exclusion from the MICHELIN Cup.
- 6.5. Penalties for the infringements of the terms of participation and obligation of advertisement will be appointed by the MICHELIN Cup's commission in accordance with FIA International Sporting Code.
- 6.6. All winners of Michelin Cup must let know their prize tyre preferences latest **two weeks** after the last Championship event to a local Michelin Rally tyre dealer or to Triple M Llc. In case the winner is not contacting with Michelin Cup organisers during this period, they will **lose the rights to prize tyres.**

7. PRIZES

Triple M Llc will award the winners of the MICHELIN Cup as follows:

- 7.1. Class **MICHELIN-4WD**
 - 7.1.1. 1st place – 10 tyres
 - 7.1.2. 2nd place – 4 tyres
 - 7.1.3. 3rd place – 4 tyres
- 7.2. Class **MICHELIN-2WD**
 - 7.2.1. 1st place – 8 tyres
 - 7.2.2. 2nd place – 4 tyres
 - 7.2.3. 3rd place – 4 tyres
- 7.3. Class **MICHELIN-National**
 - 7.3.1. 1st place – 8 tyres
 - 7.3.2. 2nd place – 4 tyres
 - 7.3.3. 3rd place – 4 tyres
